**DO KEEP YOUR CHILD'S DENTAL APPOINTMENT?
IF YOU MUST CANCEL, PLEASE CALL THE OFFICE AS SOON AS YOU CAN.**

Before the Visit:

- Do share with your child the good reasons for going to the dentist.
- Do calm your child about the visit. Try not to use words such as "Hurt," "Pain," and "Bleeding" when talking about the visit to the dentist.
- Do talk about your child's first visit in a good way.
- Do stay in the waiting room if asked to do so by the dentist or the staff.
- Do keep friends, brothers, and sisters from trying to scare your child about the dentist.

At the Office:

- Do visit the dentist with clean teeth.
- Do bring your child's health plan ID card.
- Do bring only the child who has an appointment to the dental office.
